Maple syrup is a natural agricultural product; and

WHEREAS:

Maple syrup is produced throughout Minnesota and many communities

organize maple syrup festivals in the weeks surrounding the annual sap

runs; and

WHEREAS:

Minnesota is one of 19 states that produces pure maple syrup and is the

western-most producing state in the United States; and

WHEREAS:

Producers from Minnesota have won state, national, and international

awards for the quality of their maple syrup.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of March 2017, as:

MAPLE SYRUP MONTH

in the state of Minnesota.
