Must be taken by maple producer or maple industry professional or an immediate family member. Individual photos must be no smaller than 5X7" and no larger than 8X10". Name, address and entry category clearly indicated on the back of each entry. Winners will be selected by popular ballot vote of convention attendees and announced at the banquet on Wednesday evening. Pictures will be available for pick-up/return after the Wednesday banquet. 1st place winners in each category will receive a plaque.
